Development History

Hosted first gathering in November 2016, Port of Caddo-Bossier

• Representatives were asked: "What issues impacting your business keep you up at night?"

January 2017 follow-up meeting firmed up priority areas and led to formation of two Working Groups around top priorities:

- Marketing modern manufacturing to our communities
- Defining critical talent pathways & developing deep partnerships with education/training providers

Identified North Louisiana Manufacturing Week (program of NLEP & NWLA MMC) as perfect tool to market manufacturing to future workforce (1,100 student tours across ten parishes; 31 tour sites)
